

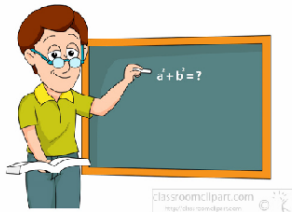
# *...that students, staff, and the school can benefit from restorative practices?*

Restorative practices have been associated with improvements in students' perceptions of disciplinary fairness and overall school climate and improved relationships. Restorative practices have also been associated with reductions in racial/ethnic disparities in disciplinary outcomes. All members of a school community can benefit from restorative practices



## **Students can benefit from**

- learning that inappropriate behavior may violate rules but it also harms real people
- learning how to take responsibility for their behavior
- learning that they can make things right



## **Teachers can benefit from**

- improved teacher-student and student-student relationships
- investing time in relationship building to reduce time lost to behavioral incidents and behavioral redirection



## **Schools can benefit from**

- improvements in school climate
- reductions in racial/ethnic disparities in discipline
- fewer disciplinary infractions



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
